This website, www.gltp.at, is operated by *Rechtsanwälte Grassner, Lenz, Thewanger & Partner* (in English: Grassner, Lenz, Thewanger & Partners, attorneys at law), Company Register No. 140793z, Südtirolerstrasse 4-6, 4020 Linz, Austria („GLTP“).

To the extent that the term “data processing“ is being used in the following, this covers any action carried out in connection with personal data such as its collection, organisation, structuring, storage, adaptation or alteration, its retrieval, consultation, use, disclosure by transmission, dissemination or otherwise making it available, its alignment or combination, its restriction, erasure or destruction (Article 4 EU GDPR).

The processing of personal data relates to the following information:

- the user’s browser type and version used
- the user’s operating system
- the user’s internet service provider
- the user’s IP address
- the date and time of access to our website
- websites through which the user’s system accessed our website
- websites accessed by the user’s system through our website
- cookies processed and stored by GLTP.

This data is stored in our system’s logfiles. It is not stored together with any other of the user’s personal data.

A. Data Controller

Rechtsanwälte Grassner, Lenz, Thewanger & Partner, Company Register 140793z, Südtirolerstrasse 4-6, 4020 Linz, Austria, acts as the Responsible Data Controller (as defined in the EU GDPR).

B. Processing of your Personal Data

Each time you visit our website, we use so-called cookies which automatically collect certain data.

Cookies are small files which are placed on your computer when you visit our website to facilitate navigation through our site, to use the website where you left it and to store and retrieve preferences and settings for your next visit. Cookies can neither access, read nor change other information stored on your computer. Most cookies on our website are so-called session cookies which are automatically deleted after you leave our website. Permanent cookies, on the other hand, stay on your computer until you manually delete them in your browser.

GLTP's server uses permanent cookies to recognize you when you come back to our website. If you wish to control the use of cookies on your computer, you can adjust your browser settings in such a way that you will be notified when a cookie is about to be placed on your browser. Once they have been placed there, cookies can be stored, blocked or deleted.

Your personal data is being processed for us to put our website at your disposal, to continually improve and further develop it, to create statistics on its use and to detect, prevent and examine possible attacks against it.

C. Google Analytics

Our website uses neither Google Analytics nor any other web analysis service.

D. Rights of Data Subjects

You are entitled, at any time, to obtain information on your personal data we store, to have this personal data corrected, deleted and/or supplemented, to request that the processing and transmission of such personal data be restricted, by sending us a message either to office@gltp.at or by mail, to the extent that this is not prevented by a legitimate interest and/or by statutory requirements subject to Article 6 EU GDPR. Your rights also include the possibility for you to place a complaint with the competent authorities.

The legal basis for the processing of your personal data is our overriding legitimate interest, subject to Article 6 Section 1 lit. f of the EU GDPR, which, in short, consists in achieving the purposes mentioned above. At the same time, your consent, pursuant to Article 6 Section 1 a of the EU GDPR forms the legal basis for the processing of your personal data. Once you have given us your consent, the processing of your personal data for specific purposes is considered to be lawful. Your consent to having your personal data processed can be revoked at any time. This also applies to any withdrawal of consent given before the EU GDPR has come into effect, i.e. prior to 25 May 2018. A withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of any personal data processed up to that time.

E. Server Log Files

The website's provider automatically collects and stores information in server log files that your browser automatically sends to us. This includes information on

- the user's browser type and the version used
- the user's operating system
- the user's internet service provider
- the user's IP address
- the date and time of access to our website
- websites through which the user's system accessed our website
- websites accessed by the user's system through our website.

This data is not assignable to particular persons and will not be merged with any other sources of data. GLTP reserves the right to verify this data subsequently in the event of justified indications of its unlawful use.

F. Storage Place and Storage Time

As a general rule, any webserver log data is stored for two weeks only.

Your personal data will be securely stored by the Provider only. It will not be shared with third parties.

G. Amendments

GLTP reserves the right to adapt the information contained in this privacy notice to meet the requirements of any change in the applicable legislation and/or case law and to do so without prior notice. The current version published here shall be the only valid version.
